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## TO REMEMBER

#### TRAFFIC FROM MODANE

Snow tyres are compulsory; if necessary, carry chains or socks in your boot (from 1 November to 31 March).

If the weather conditions are not optimal (road not covered in snow, for example), stop at Modane and put on your equipment.

A word of advice: practise putting them on before setting off on your holiday. Don't worry!

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

## **AVRIEUX**

In the heart of the Maurienne valley, between the villages of Aussois and La Norma, Avrieux nestles at the foot of a rocky cirque crowned to the east by the barrier of the Esseillon forts and indented to the north by the Saint Benoît waterfall.

At the gateway to the Vanoise National Park, the village enjoys an exceptional Mediterranean mountain climate, which favours a flora and fauna unique to the region. These characteristics have earned it the nickname of 'little Nice'.

Behind its nonchalant village appearance, Avrieux surprises more than a few visitors, who are surprised to discover a small mountain village combining distinctive character, tradition and modernity.

Other heritage sites to discover include the ONERA, the Chappe telegraph, the Marie-Thérèse Redoubt and its 'Soldier's Bowl', the Church of Saint Thomas Becket, the Chapel of Notre-Dame-des-Neiges and the Chapel of Saint Benoît.

The village has no amenities, so make a stop in Modane or the ski resort for your shopping!



## **AUSSOIS**

PGet your hat and gloves ready! Just 7km from the residence, you'll find a family-friendly, south-facing ski resort. This little winter wonderland offers activities for all tastes and abilities. With 55km of sun-drenched pistes at altitudes of between 1,500m and 2,750m, it's a real paradise for alpine skiers.

But that's not all! The resort also boasts a 30km Nordic ski area called 'Le Monolithe', as well as a host of offpiste activities for the more adventurous.

Bonus: the many forts and buildings in the landscape are a testament to the region's history. So, who's ready for a mountain adventure?

## LA NORMA

Just 7 km from the residence, La Norma is a white paradise for ski lovers. With 65 km of pistes and a vertical drop of 1400 metres, it is wonderfully situated on two mountainsides. What's more, it offers views of the surrounding mountains and the Vanoise National Park. Facing north-west, it benefits from quality snow cover that will delight all skiers, whether beginners or experienced.





### DOMAINE NORDIQUE - 1740m - 2000m

The slopes are all marked out in alternating and skating technique, so you can enjoy long runs and get a good feeling right from the first days on the slopes.

Hours of relaxation or sport, at your own pace, surrounded by vast expanses of snow and larch forests, in a natural setting where the Charbonnel is always there to reveal its incredible glacier.



Many families, parents and grandparents alike, choose Bessans for the comfort and convenience it offers them: they can ski for miles on cross-country skis or go for walks on the snowshoe or footpaths, while their children learn to ski downhill or cross-country, of course.
